GIVE PERSON SEVERAL GLASSES OF WATER FOLLOWED BY CITRUS FRUIT JUICE. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.
